The Harbour School Statement of Provision

Introductory statement

The Harbour School is a Special Free School in Dorset. The school specialises in Autistic Spectrum Conditions (ASC), Speech, Language and Communication needs related Anxiety, Social, Emotional and Mental Health conditions. Our flexible, therapeutic curriculum, underpinned by emotional literacy, is focussed on engaging young people in learning. The curriculum model includes GCSEs, A Levels and accredited vocational options. Personal & Social development supports life skills including financial capability, domestic skills, employability skills, health & safety and an awareness of diversity. Our vision is that young people will experience an emotionally healthy environment that prepares them exceptionally well for the next stage of their education, employment or training.

We believe that by meeting individual need in a supportive and therapeutic environment we can reduce barriers to learning, develop resilience, create opportunities and build futures. Our Free School will provide an exciting curriculum underpinned by academic rigour and specific, evidence-based, therapeutic interventions to meet individual need.

Admissions to the School

The Harbour School is a special school which provides 160 places for children of both sexes in the age range 10 – 19 specialising in provision for Autistic Spectrum Conditions (ASC), Speech, Language and Communication needs, related Anxiety, Social, Emotional and Mental Health conditions who are able to access a suitably differentiated curriculum.

For a child to be admitted, the school must be named, by a local authority, in the child's education health and care plan ('EHCP')

Parents wishing their children to benefit from our provision should ask their local authority to name our school in their child's EHCP.
