- A safe, caring and supportive environment where staff are trained in positive handling (positive handling will be used where necessary, including restraints and holds to protect you, others or property)

- To have all personal items which were handed in returned (except where possession of those items may be illegal. e.g. knives, prohibited substances)
- To provide appropriate transport for activities
